



**2018 Adventure Ride
The Acadiana Adventure 400**

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Dual Sport Bike-friendly (with gas available every 50 miles – bring your own can)

400 miles of scenic forest roads, back roads, gravel and unimproved paved roads:

Day 1: 215 miles - A full day of back road touring through the rolling hills of North Louisiana's pine forests. Enjoy awesome Louisiana landscape and historic sites while traveling numerous parish country roads, National Forest roads and scenic by-ways.

Day2: 145 miles - Another full day of riding on back roads through pine forests and local countryside.

AMA-sanctioned event. All 100% rideable, with optional hero sections on both days. Navigation is by roll chart. This is a self-guided tour. Club members are available to escort those not familiar with roll-chart navigation. Also will have a chase truck for emergencies (not repairs – no time). Garmin GPS upload available at sign-up. Several gas stops on routes for both days. Rides on both days start and end at Cotille Lake Recreational Area (event headquarters).

Bikes must be street legal in the state of registration, have a current license plate and adequate insurance. Bikes riding Hero sections must have USFS-approved spark arrestor. Ride at your own risk.

EVENT HEADQUARTERS:

Cotille Lake Recreational Area, Boyce, LA. 100 RV sites and primitive tent camping available. Five hotels 15 miles away.

ENTRY FEE: \$120 for both days, passenger \$40 extra. \$80.00 for one day (includes supper, lunch and t-shirt). Pre-entry includes lunch on both days, dinner Saturday night, and event T-shirt. Online registration and payment available on club website. Pre-entry strongly encouraged so we can plan for adequate food and t-shirts.
